## Disagreeing with a Proposed Budget

#### Language in Use

Negotiations involve listening to and presenting opinions with clear, straightforward reasons

- · When disagreeing with an opinion, state your reasons and suggest alternative options.
- · Clarify unclear points or opinions, and ask for reasons if the other side's suggestions don't agree with your ideas.
